



2024/25 Midseason Showcase Information & Guide

General Information

- Our 2024/25 Midseason Showcase is Saturday January 11th 2025 at the Seven Oaks Performing Arts Centre (711 Jefferson Ave, Winnipeg, MB).
- We will have 3 shows. Each class/dance will perform in one show.
- The GREEN SHOW will start promptly at 10:00am. Doors will open for audience members at 9:30am.
- The BLUE SHOW will start promptly at 12:00pm. Doors will open for audience members at 11:30pm.
- The PINK SHOW will start promptly at 2:00pm. Doors will open for audience members at 1:30pm.
- If your dancer is in multiple classes or Performance Company they may perform in multiple shows. With so many dance families we try our best to put all classes each dancer takes and all family members in the same show but this is not always possible.
- All dancers will perform their choreographed dances for all audience members and other students in costume, in a state of the art performing arts theatre complete with a stage, lights, wings, dressing rooms, raised seating and MORE!
- Please make sure you have the costume, hair & makeup document for your classes as this will be needed for recital day. It is mandatory that dancers wear clean, hole-free tights, and a beige bodyliner under their costumes at all times. You can find it on the show hub [here](#).

Tickets & Recital Gift Packs

- Tickets to the show and recital gift pack can be purchased beginning **October 29 2024 for GOLD Club TDC Members** and **SILVER Club TDC Members**, **October 30 2024 for BRONZE Club TDC Members**, and **November 1, 2024 for all other dancers and the public** right [here](#).
- There are no limits on the amount of extra tickets you can purchase. There is however a limited amount of seating for each show and the shows will sell out. It is highly recommended to purchase tickets VERY SOON after sales open.
- Most dancers bring all their supporters to watch their recital performances. Grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, neighbours and friends are all welcome but please leave pets at home as our venue does not welcome pets of any kind.
- Parent Volunteers DO NOT need to purchase tickets for the shows they are volunteering in.

- Ticket Pricing:
 - **Ticket prices will be tiered (different prices for different seats). Prices range from \$16.90 - \$25.60 + taxes and service fees for Early Bird tickets (Ends December 1, 2024) . Prices range from \$22.05 - \$30.75 + taxes and service fees for regular priced tickets (December 1, 2024 and beyond).**
 - If your immediate family (students that live at the same address) is in more than 1 show, you'll purchase tickets for one show and we'll match the amount of tickets purchased (at the same or lower priced tier) for all other shows they are in for FREE. You'll enter your dancer's name during the checkout process and the discount will be applied automatically. Please note, it will look like you'll be charged full price for all tickets until the very end of the checkout process.

Gift Packs

- After choosing your tickets you'll have the option to purchase gift packs for your performers and loved ones! It's a theatre tradition to give gifts to performers after they are done performing.

- **We'll be donating a portion of the proceeds from every gift pack purchase to our Performance Company Travel Fund.** All donations received towards the performance company travel fund will be split equally amongst all dancers participating in our next performance trip which is to Europe in 2026! This will help offset the investment required to travel, perform and experience this once in a lifetime opportunity for all dancers and help more students be able to participate. You'll also have an option to just make a donation to the Performance Company travel fund.

RECITAL DAY

Arrival

- Dancers must arrive in full costume with hair and makeup complete. Dancers are to wear clean, hole-free tights and a **beige bodyliner** under their tights at all times. Find costume, hair & make up information for each class [here](#).
- Dancers in multiple dances, please read the spreadsheets below VERY carefully. This is the show order for each show. Please arrive in the costume for the dance you will be performing first and bring all of your other costumes with you.
- An arrival schedule for each show is listed below. **Please arrive at your ARRIVAL TIME. Please read the schedule VERY carefully as it is NOT in the order the dancers arrive, it is in the order they will be performing in during the show.**
- **Dancers will be dropped off at their arrival time at the backstage check in table located in the lobby of the Seven Oaks Performing Arts Centre.** It won't be hard to find once you enter through the front doors.

During

- Please note that for the safety and privacy of all of our dancers, there will be no personal recording of performances permitted. We have hired a professional videographer and photographer to record all the recital performances. There is a digital video copy of the performances included in your child's participation package.
- All dancers will be supervised by our volunteers from the time they arrive until they are picked up at the end of the show. Even our youngest dancers are in very good hands. Dancers will not be released to their parents/guardians until after the show is complete.
- To show the utmost respect for ALL of our dancers it is expected that all audience members remain in the audience and enjoy the entire show. Please do not leave in the middle of a show unless it is an emergency. Each show is about 45 minutes long.
- **Dancers are not permitted to bring any personal belongings backstage other than the costumes and dance shoes they need for the current show.** Parents will need to keep all outdoor shoes, jackets, etc. with them. We recommend bringing a reusable bag to put your dancers shoes and jackets in before they go backstage. **Drop dancers off in their tights, beige bodyliner and uniform, and shoes they will be dancing in.** No other items will be permitted backstage.
- Please bring a reusable bag for your dancer's coats and boots and all other belongings. There will be cups for water backstage. Every dancer (regardless of age) will only be allowed backstage with the items they will be performing in for that show and medical equipment, NO EXCEPTIONS.

After

- **1 parent/guardian from each family** will go to the Stage left door (we'll give you directions on how to find this during the show, it's super easy) to collect their dancer(s) after the show is complete. Please bring ID with you.
- **All costumes must be returned to the studio before leaving the venue.**
